



Grading Outline for At-Home Learning - Phase 3 - Elementary

As we begin Phase 3 of our at-home learning plan, we recognize the many challenges that teachers and families have faced while adjusting to this new form of teaching and learning. In order to more clearly define the expectations of our students, we have outlined a few important topics in regards to grading and report cards.

Quarter 3 Report Cards

Students and families have already received their report cards for the 3rd Quarter. As you know, all students in grades kindergarten through 5th grade received a N/A (Not Assessed), or an NG (Not Graded) for students in 6th grade. Descriptors for content areas were scored on a 1-4 based on effort and participation for the whole quarter. Comments provided were based on each student's effort and participation during Phase 1 of the at-home learning plan. While this decision meant that students did not receive a "grade" on their report card, their work still counts; schoolwork that was completed during the first 5 weeks of the 3rd quarter will be factored into 4th quarter grade determinations.

Quarter 4 Report Cards

The start date of the 4th quarter began on April 20th and any work completed from that point on is graded and will be used. Students will be graded for the 4th quarter on a PASS/INCOMPLETE basis. This determination will be made based on the following factors:

- The students grade for the first 5 weeks of the 3rd Quarter;
- The students' effort and participation during the at-home learning plan for all work beginning on April 1st to the end of the school year;
- The level to which students completed the assignments.

Final Grades

A student's final grade for the school year will also be determined as PASS or INCOMPLETE. This determination will be made based on the students' grade for the first 25 weeks of school (while in session) and their effort, participation and completion of assignments during the at-home learning plan. There will be more detailed information as we approach the end of the school year.
