On orientation day, please bring with you:

3 packages of glue sticks (all regular size sticks of glue)

1 backpack (not toddler size, the school folder doesn't fit)

Clorox/Lysol wipes

2 packages of baby wipes

1 complete change of clothes to be kept in the cubby

1 small pillow & small blanket to be kept in the cubby

1 set of <u>headphones of appropriate size</u> (no earbuds)

If your child's last name begins with the letters A-G:

2 boxes of sandwich sized ziploc bags

If your child's last name begins with the letters H-Z:

1 box of gallon sized ziploc bags

Please <u>DO NOT</u> send in a box of crayons or pencils. We use special sized crayons and pencils that are meant for your child's fine motor development.

PS – Remember to label everything with your child's name.






