40 - Purchased Services	Many of the district's families who experience homelessness struggle with providing basic clothing needs to their children, especially during the winter months. The district partnered with "The Angel Fund," which is a local non-profit organization that supports families who face economic hardship, including families who are experiencing homelessness or uncertain housing situations to provide appropriate winter clothing to students. The "Angel Fund" purchased winter coats, snow pants, hats, gloves/ mittens, and boats to give to families who are facing economic uncertainty and housing uncertainty to provide these winter clothing needs. The need to provide these items to families facing these situations has never been greater, therefore the district partnered with the "Angel Fund" to identify families who met this criteria, and reimbursed the "Angel Fund" for their purchased items, which were then distributed to the identified families.
